- 7. I find Plaintiff Yolanda Acevedo 40% at fault and Defendant Randel Jablonecki 60% at fault.

Property damage: \$801.27 Medical bills: \$1,550.00

I direct the Clerk to enter judgment for Plaintiff Yolanda Acevedo for \$5,000.00 plus costs to be taxed by the Clerk.
