ARBITRAL AWARD

2. Plaintiff Almaineta Davis struck the left front portion of Defendant April N. DeGourville's Acura Integra as Plaintiff Almaineta Davis merged onto the highway.

3. I reach this conclusion from a careful review of the police report in this action, despite the fact Plaintiff

Almaineta Davis was not convicted of making an improper  
turn.

4. Around the same period, Plaintiff Almaineta Davis  
had a number of accidents:

July 28, 1999  
September 8, 1999  
September 15, 1999 (this one)  
September 30, 1999

Judgment shall enter in favor of Defendant April N.  
DeGourville, plus costs to be taxed.
